APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

We welcome your interest in enrolling your child(ren) in Loudonville Christian School. Admission is based on the Admissions Policy statement. It is important that the Admissions Policy, the Statement of Faith, and Application Procedures be read carefully.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- (1) Complete the Application for Admission and forward it to LCS.
- (2) Complete Section 1 of the Pastor's Recommendation and mail or deliver it to your pastor. The pastor should be asked to complete and return this form directly to the school.
- (3) For each student applying, the following must be provided:
 - a. A completed Application for Admission
 - b. Proof of age for students entering Preschool through First Grade (i.e. copy of birth certificate)
 - c. The student's transcript. (First grade and kindergarten students exempt.)
 - d. Record of student achievement (report cards), a record of standardized test results and other professional records (testing, counseling, special education, etc.)
 - e. Documented record of immunizations
- (4) Entrance testing is required for admission. The school will notify parents of testing dates after the application has been completed. (Recent achievement test results may be accepted in lieu of an entrance examination.)
- (5) Upon receipt of the completed Application for Admission and the record of achievement, an interview is scheduled with the Principal. The purpose of this interview is to receive a personal Christian testimony from the parent(s)/guardian(s), to discuss the school and its programs, and to review the student's record. Students applying for grades 7 - 12 will complete an essay and will have an interview with the Principal.
- (6) Upon completion of the family interview, a decision regarding admission to the school will be made. Acceptance or rejection of applicants will be by written notification.
- (7) Early application is recommended.

ADMISSIONS POLICY

It is the policy of the Loudonville Christian School to admit children of Christian families who have affirmed that they have read the Statement of Faith and agree to have their children educated according to it.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

- We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God.
- We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, and in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
- We believe that for salvation of lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely necessary.
- We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a Godly life.
- We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost: they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
- We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.
