

## FINANCIAL AID

It is the policy of Loudonville Christian School to keep tuition and fees charged by the school at a modest level so that as many children as possible may benefit from Christian school education. Each year as part of its operating budget the School Board allots a specified amount for financial aid for the next academic year. Things to remember when applying for Financial Aid:

- Complete the School and Student Service for Financial Aid (SSS) Parent Financial Statement. These forms are available in the school office. Mail the completed application to SSS for processing by March 31, 2008 to be considered for Financial Aid for the 2008-2009 school year. Statements mailed after March 31, 2008 may not be considered for Financial Aid. Applications may also be made on-line at <http://www.nais.org/financialaid/sss> by March 31, 2008.
- Families are required to submit a copy of their 2007 Federal 1040. This copy must be submitted to the LCS Main Office no later than April 15, 2008.
- In order to be considered for Financial Aid, the following requirements must be met:
  - Students must have a GPA of "C" and exhibit a positive attitude and behavior.
  - Current year's Tuition Billing Account must be current.
  - Students must be registered for the school year for which financial aid application is being made. This means that the enrollment process must be complete by returning the completed Family Registration Agreement, Tuition Worksheet and Family Tuition Deposit. Only registered students will be considered for Financial Aid.

Using the SSS calculated Expected Family Contribution to rank need, Financial Aid is awarded to each qualified, registered family based on available aid, the tuition to be incurred and need ranking. Families will receive award notification May 2008.
