STUDENT LEADERSHIP MODEL

The prestigious leadership model that LCS ascribes to is referred to as the Prefect Model. Five senior students are selected from a faculty panel to each serve as a student leader, known as a prefect. The senior prefects are meant to create and sustain a positive culture within the school. They each build a committee of 7th-12th graders to help them accomplish their goals. They meet regularly with a faculty mentor and plan numerous events throughout the year.
