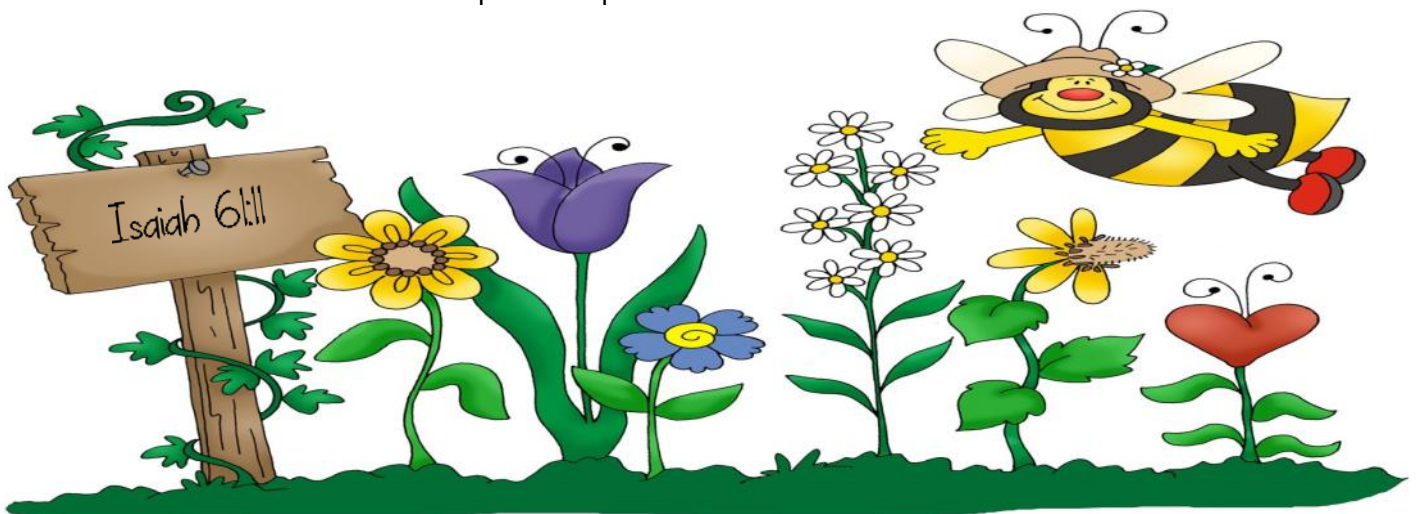

- The meningococcal vaccine has been **required** for school entry since Sept. 1, 2016.

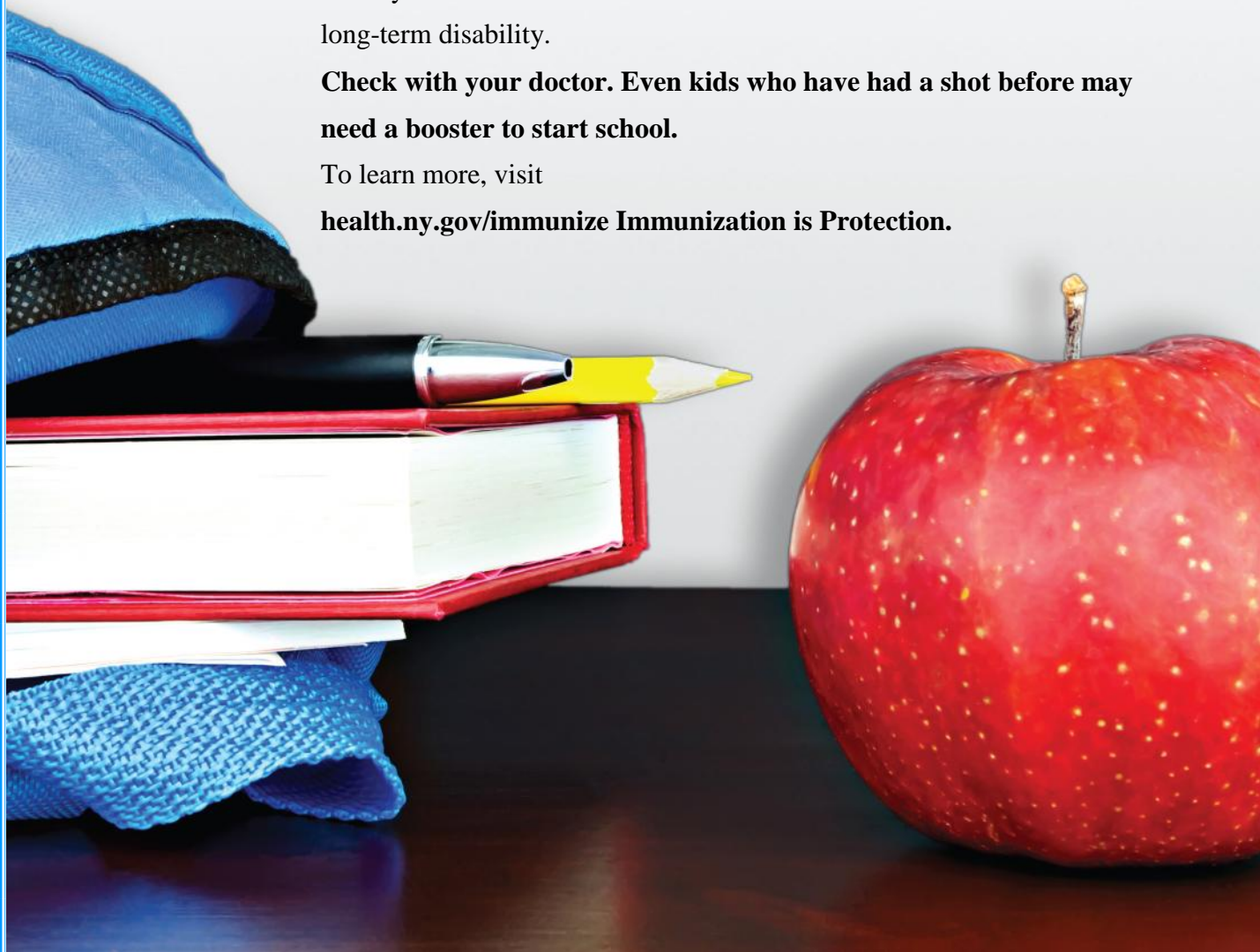
### About Meningococcal Disease:

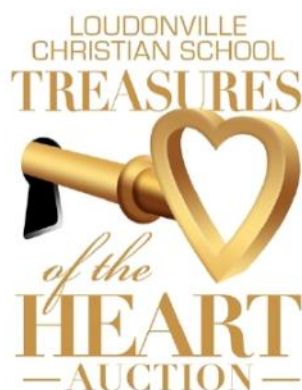
- It causes **bacterial meningitis** and other serious diseases.
