Parking on school grounds is a special privilege afforded to high school students. In order to have permission to drive to school and park on school grounds, a student must exhibit responsible behavior in school.

The following form is intended to supply information. **Please fill out and present it along with a copy of the student's driver's license, vehicle registration, and insurance card to the Principal.** If you may be driving several different cars, please supply the requested information on all vehicles. When there is a change of vehicle, it is important that you submit an update. Once all of the required information is supplied, you will receive a Student Driver Sticker which must be displayed in your vehicle where it can be easily seen while standing outside. This form must be renewed every school year.
