



## FIFTH GRADE SUPPLY LIST

Dear Future Fifth Grader,

Are you ready to begin a new adventure? This year will be full of new opportunities for you to grow academically, spiritually, and socially. I am praying for you until we meet again in September.

Please see below for the supplies you will need to start the new school year. These items will need to be brought to school on the first day unless otherwise noted. I hope you have the chance to get outside and make some wonderful memories this summer. I look forward to hearing all about it!

**Some items may need to be replenished later in the year.**

- 2 large boxes of Kleenex
  - 1 bag of individually-wrapped candy (ex. chocolates, airheads, skittles, mints, etc. )
  - 1 large container of disinfectant wipes
  - 24 sharpened pencils
  - 3 pads of yellow Post-it notes (3x3 size)
  - 1 box of erasable colored pencils (8 count is fine -these are for corrections, so erasable is vital)
  - 1 box of crayons (8 count is fine)
  - 1 1-inThree ring binder(white, with clear encasing on the outside in which to slip a title page)
  - 1 150 pg. pack of wide-ruled paper – loose leaf
  - 200 index cards (one a package, another on a ring for Spanish class)
  - 1 fun folder that you love, 3-hole punched. Label this folder on the outside “study hall”
  - Another fun folder- label one side “stays at home” and the other side “return to school”
  - 4 folders with pockets
    - 1 green folder labeled Science on the outside
    - 1 blue folder labeled Social Studies on the outside
    - 1 purple folder labeled Bible on the outside
    - 1 yellow folder labeled ELA
  - 1 red 1 subject spiral notebook labeled Math
  - 1 green 1 subject spiral notebook labeled Science/Social Studies
  - 1 yellow 1 subject spiral notebook labeled Reading
  - 2 composition notebook (any color, one will be decorated, the other is for Spanish )
  - 2 large erasers
  - A pair of scissors
  - 1 highlighter
  - 2 dry erase markers
  - 3 glue sticks
  - a pair of inexpensive earbuds & case
  - 1 soft pencil case (for a few pencils, highlighter, post it pad, pink eraser, earbuds , glue stick)
  - 1 hard pencil case to keep in cubby to hold other loose supplies
  - Sketch book: 8-1/2" x 11" or 9" x 12", 50 sheets, spiral bound, 70#weight (for art)
