STUDENT LEADERSHIP MODEL

The prestigious leadership model that LCS ascribes to is referred to as the Prefect Model. Five senior students are selected from a faculty panel to serve as a prefect. The senior prefects are meant to create and sustain a positive culture within the school. They each build a committee of 7th-12th graders to help them accomplish their goals. They meet regularly with a faculty mentor and plan numerous events throughout the year. When a Prefect applies to a college an additional letter will be attached to their recommendation. This letter will give a thorough description of our student leadership model.

TECHNOLOGY

Our high school students receive a personal iPad their freshman year. Students regularly use their iPads for academic purposes in class and at home.

STUDENT INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Students have the option to enroll as an intern with local businesses and organizations. Internships are offered during the fall and spring semester of their senior year. Internship Seminar is a prerequisite offered in the spring semester of their junior year.

SERV-A-THONS

Serving the local community is a priority and an integral part of the LCS culture. Three days a year classes are cancelled and students serve in a variety of capacities around the Capital Region.
