



Pre-Kindergarten Supply List

The following items are needed by the first day of school:

- **A BACKPACK** – While they make smaller backpacks that are designed specifically for Pre-Kinder, they are generally too small. Instead opt for a small size backpack.
- **LUNCH BOX**- This is to store snack and lunch in the classroom. I suggest you put a small ice pack in the lunch box to keep items cold.
- **WATER BOTTLE**- We get thirsty throughout the day and instead of using the water fountain and getting drenched we prefer to have a water bottle that we store in our cubbies for easy access. (We do ask that it is filled with water and not juice. They can drink juice at snack and lunch.)
- **1 “BLACK” 1” BINDERS Clear View** – These are for our ABC books. (please label on the inside).
- **SHEET PROTECTORS** – We need about 50 of these to go inside our ABC notebooks. (Please fill one of the black binders with these).
- **FOLDER**- This will help us send messages back and forth from home to school and for projects to make it home safely. A plastic one will last the whole year while a paper one might need to be replaced.
- **SMALL FLASHLIGHT**- We will be using these throughout the year for different activities.
- **LARGE STERILITE CONTAINER**- We will be using this for center class time and as little desks. 14” x 11” Target link- <https://www.target.com/p/sterilite-clip-storage-box-green/-/A-14758436#lnk=sametab>
- **BABY WIPES**- For washing hands and cleaning faces
- **TISSUES**- For our snotty noses
- **4 BLACK DRY ERASE MARKERS**- We will use these for letter and name practice throughout the year
- **A NEW WHITE T-SHIRT**- These are for our end of the year shirts so plan on your child growing slightly through the year. Short sleeve is ideal since it will be June. You can pick one up at Hobby Lobby for under \$3.
- **REST TIME STUFF** -For students staying for the afternoon: a small pillow and blanket with your student's name for rest time. These need to be stored in a reusable shopping bag. Please no regular size pillow they don't fit in our cubbies. (I will be washing these bi-weekly)
- **EXTRA CLOTHES**- Kids get messy quickly. A seasonally appropriate well-fitting change of clothes is essential. Whether they have an accident or spill on themselves, please pack these in a Zip-loc bag to be stored in their cubbies. Label all clothes so frazzled teachers know what cubby it belongs in.
