6th Grade

- One subject notebook (green preferred)
- Green pocket folder
- 3+ glue sticks
- small scissors (keep in backpack)
- Assorted colored pencils
- Highlighter
- Pencils/erasers
- Assignment Notebook

7th Grade

- 70 page one subject notebook
- Calculator (the one you use for math is fine)
- Assorted color pens
- 1" binder
- Yellow highlighter

8th Grade

- 1" three ring binder for notes (with 2-3 dividers)
- Colored pencils
- Pencils/erasers
- Loose leaf paper
- Assignment notebook

Pre-AP Biology (Biology)

- 1" 3 ring binder for notes
- Red pens, blue/black pens, pencils
- Small pack of graph paper
- Loose leaf paper

Analytical Biology (Pre-AP Honors Biology)

- 1" 3 ring binder
- Composition notebook (unused, 100 pages would be ideal, as we will fill the ENTIRE notebook over the course of the year)
- glue stick
- pen of a different color than what they take notes in (NOT red)
- highlighter

Chemistry Honors

- 1-1.5" Binder
