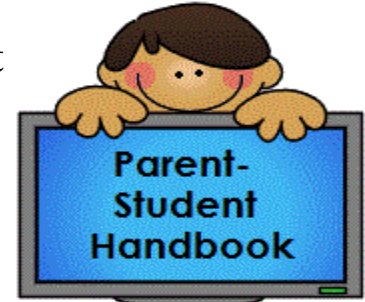


Wednesday, September 27 is School Picture Day! Order forms have been sent home with students. Please remind your student(s) to hand their completed form to the Lifetouch photographer.
