#### **LCS Statement of Faith**

- We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible Word of God, fully authoritative in matters of faith and conduct. (2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:21)
- We believe that there is only one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. (Genesis 1:1; Matthew 28:19; John 10:30, 37-38)
- We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 10:33-36), in His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:23; Luke 1:35), in His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15, 7:26, 9:12), in His miracles (John 2:11), and in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood (1 Corinthians 15:3; Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14; Hebrews 2:9), in His bodily resurrection (John 11:25; 1 Corinthians 15:4), in His ascension to the right hand of God the Father (Luke 24:51; Acts 1:9; Hebrews 1:3), and in His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11; Revelation 19:11).
- We believe that for salvation of lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely necessary. (Romans 3:10, 23; John 3:16-19, 5:24; Ephesians 2:8-10; Titus 3:5-6)
- We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life. (Ephesians 3:16, 4:30; 1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19)
- We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost: they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation. (John 5:28-29)
- We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 8:9; 1 Corinthians 12:12-13; Galatians 3:26-28)

#### LCS LIFESTYLE STATEMENT

Loudonville Christian School is a religious institution providing an education in a distinct Christian environment, and it believes that its biblical role is to work in conjunction with the home to mold students to be Christ like. In accordance with LCS Policy, Loudonville Christian School stands firmly upon the historical truth claims and moral foundations of Christianity. These truth claims include, but are not limited to, the biblical definition of marriage, the attendant boundaries of sexuality and moral conduct, and the clear biblical teaching that gender is both sacred and established by God's design.

We believe that the Bible teaches that human life is sacred in God's sight. Murder, suicide, euthanasia, and abortion are offenses against the sanctity of human life. (Genesis 9:5-6; Psalm 139:13; Matthew 19:18-19; Romans 13:8-10)

We believe that the Bible reveals that God created marriage as the union of one man and one woman joined together in an exclusive, lifelong relationship. (Genesis 2:18-25) The Bible makes it clear that God frowns upon divorce, and that divorce is acceptable only in certain limited circumstances. Offenses against marriage and the family such as domestic violence and child abuse are displeasing to God, in addition to being punishable by the state. (Ephesians 5:22-6:4) The Bible teaches that God intends sexual intimacy to only occur between one man and one woman who are married to one another, and the Bible clearly directs that no sexual activity be engaged in outside of marriage. (Genesis 1:27-28, 2:21-24; Matthew 19:4-9; Mark 10:5-9; 1 Corinthians 6:18-20; 1

Thessalonians 4:1-8) Furthermore, no definition of marriage other than the union of one man and one woman shall be recognized at Loudonville Christian School.

We believe that the Bible further teaches that God created humankind, male and female. It is impossible for a person to truly change his/her sex. The assertion of a gender identity different from one's biological sex is fundamentally at odds with God's creative intent for a person's life, as is the assertion of a sexual identity that departs from heterosexuality. (Genesis 1:26-28, 5:1-2)

We believe that the Bible teaches that God offers forgiveness, redemption, and restoration to all who confess and forsake their sin, seeking His mercy and forgiveness through Jesus Christ. (1 John 1:9) Loudonville Christian School believes that every person must be afforded compassion, love, grace, kindness, respect, and dignity. (Matthew 7:12; Philippians 2:1-4)

Loudonville Christian School adheres to these Biblically-based beliefs and considers them essential to our identity as a Christian school. Parents who choose to enroll their children at Loudonville Christian School understand that the School will teach these principles and biblical values.

On those occasions in which the atmosphere or conduct within a particular home or behaviors of a student is counter to or in opposition to the biblical lifestyle the school teaches as referenced and outlined within the Parent-Student Handbook (pp. 39-41) and in accordance with the Scriptures, the school reserves the right, within its sole discretion, to refuse admission of an applicant or to discontinue enrollment of a student.

#### INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TUITION AND INSURANCE

#### 2022-2023

#### INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TUITION:

- Application Fee: \$250. Non-refundable but is applied to tuition.
- Total Tuition: \$28,000 (annual cost)
- Tuition is paid in full once student has gone through the admissions process, been accepted and is ready to enroll. The tuition payment is non-refundable but Loudonville Christian School does offer, through a third party, a tuition insurance plan which covers a portion of unused tuition should the student need to be withdrawn. (Cost is 2.8% of full tuition).
- Tuition will cover education and academic support, textbooks/workbooks, MacBook, required field trips, high school
  retreat, athletic fee, yearbook, student accident insurance (not health insurance), and university level/dual enrollment
  course fees for grades 11 and 12.
- Items not covered by tuition include: missions/international trips, school purchased lunches, personal LCS sports team apparel, or class supplies.
- Additional academic tutoring may be billed as needed.

#### **HEALTH INSURANCE:**

• It is required by our government that international students have health insurance. Loudonville Christian School requires proof that this insurance is in place. It is not included in tuition.

#### STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE:

• International students will automatically be covered under the LCS Student Accident Insurance policy. It is covered by tuition. This is not a health insurance plan.

#### **HOMESTAY COSTS:**

- International students who attend Loudonville Christian School (LCS) will be placed in the care of families whom LCS has accepted through a screening and application process.
- The Homestay cost is \$10,000 per school year, September to June. This fee is to be paid in full at the time of acceptance and payment of full tuition.
- If a student is living with a family member or family friend during their time studying at LCS, they do not need to pay
  homestay costs. LCS will need to receive written notification from the family or friend who the student will be living
  with explaining that they fulfill the role as the host family.

#### **OTHER FEES:**

Agency or consultant fees may apply.

#### **LIVING COSTS:**

- Students should have sufficient financial support to assure his/her well-being during the entire duration of enrollment, making sure to cover all costs, including tuition, host family costs, as well as expenses as they arise. This includes the following:
  - o Round trip international airfare, passport, and visa
  - Health, medical, dental, and accident insurance and other medical expenses not covered by insurance
  - o Any costs related to the early return of the student to his or her home country for any reason
  - o Personal day-to-day expenses such as telephone, clothes, and recreational activities
  - Additional costs as they arise
